Brief Description of Program or Service: Cindy's Bridge is a community-based independent living home that provides safe, stable, and fully furnished shared housing for adults transitioning toward long-term stability. The program offers affordable housing with utilities included, Wi-Fi, in-unit laundry, and a structured yet independent environment. Residents are supported through clear house guidelines and referrals to community resources, with a focus on dignity, accountability, and successful independent living.

Do you have storm damage?

What is DAP?

DAP is a block grant funded by the South Carolina Housing Trust Fund (HTF) to support housing recovery for owner-occupied households impacted by natural disasters. HDC coordinates local intake, eligibility, scopes of work, and contractor management.

Who is Eligible?

To be an eligible household, you must be a homeowner within Rock Hill city limits, have sustained eligible disaster-related damage, be at or below the income limits, and submit an application with all requested documentation.

How does DAP help?

- Roof repair/replacement, including fascia, soffit, and gutters
- Window replacement when a window is broken
- Siding repair/replacement
