FINANCIAL UPDATES

- SCORF Outcomes Report
 - CACH has compiled an Outcomes Report for Rock Hill City Council. This report will be shared with coalition members at next month's meeting.
- CDBG-CV
 - Grant applications are now open.
 - This grant can be used to extend, add, or maintain emergency shelter overflow services.
 - Eligible applicants must demonstrate an increased need of at least 30% from the previous calendar year and participate in HMIS.

OUTREACH UPDATES

CACH Community Referral Program - Referral Types

- Community Referrals: These referrals come through our online Community Referral Survey.
- Agency Referrals: These referrals come from local agencies looking for assistance for their client(s).
- Self Referrals: These referrals come directly from an individual or household who needs assistance. These typically come through our Facebook page or website.
- Outreach Team Engagement: These are individuals our internal team notices or makes direct contact with without a referral.





CACH Community Referral Program - March

- Eight referrals were made in the month of March.
- The Street Outreach Team followed up on all 8 referrals.
- Contact was made with 4 individuals.

 - Community Referrals: 3
 - Agency Referrals: 2
 - Self Referrals: 2
 - Outreach Team Engagement: 1

Case Management

- All Cases have been input into HMIS and Unite Us
 - Agencies can refer unsheltered clients to CACH through Unite Us.

Resource Distribution Updates

- Made contact with 71 individuals
- Gave away 368 items
- Distributed 84 SUD items
