

## HOUSING CONTINUUM OF CARE







#### Components of a CoC

- Prevention
- Diversion
- Intake, & Assessment
- Street Outreach
- Emergency Shelter
- Rapid Re-Housing & Rapid Exit
- Transitional Housing
- Community-Based Permanent Housing
- Permanent Supportive Housing



#### Prevention

- Offers aid to those at risk of homelessness through rental assistance, rent stability, housing relocation, and subsidies
- Agencies:
  - Carolina Community Actions Inc., The Housing Development Corporation, The Salvation Army, Affinity Health Center, HOPWA, No Sad Story, Clover Area Assistance





#### Diversion

- A homelessness strategy that helps people avoid shelters by offering immediate assistance to find housing solutions, aiming to prevent homelessness.
- Agencies:
  - Fullife Hope Center, Habitat for Humanity of York County



#### Intake, & Assessment

- Identify needs and link people to services
- Agencies:
  - Bethel Shelters, Family Promise, Fullife Hope Center, Habitat for Humanity, The Haven Men's Shelter, Housing Authority, Housing Development Corporation, The Life House, Pathways, Pilgrims' Inn, Salvation Army, Safe Passage, United Way 211, No Sad Story, Her Place



#### Street Outreach

- Actively seek and engage with individuals who are experiencing unsheltered homelessness in order to provide them with support, resources, and assistance to meet their immediate needs and connect them to shelter, housing, and other essential services.
- Agencies:
  - CACH, Fullife Hope Center, Churches, One80 Place



## **Emergency Shelter**

- A temporary and immediate housing option typically provided to individuals and families facing homelessness or in crisis situations.
- Agencies:
  - Bethel Shelters, Family Promise, The Life House,
     Pilgrims' Inn, Salvation Army, Safe Passage, Churches



## Rapid Re-Housing & Rapid Exit

- A housing intervention strategy designed to quickly transition individuals and families experiencing homelessness into housing. It typically includes short-term financial assistance, case management, and support services to help them regain housing stability and selfsufficiency.
- Agencies:
  - Housing Development Corporation, Safe Passage, Fullife



## CONTINUUM OF CARE

#### Transitional Housing

- Temporary, supportive living arrangements for individuals and families experiencing homelessness, with the goal of helping them stabilize their lives and eventually transition to permanent housing.
- Agencies:
  - Family Promise, The Haven Men's Shelter, Her Place, Tender Hearts, The Life House, Pilgrims' Inn, Salvation Army, Children's Attention Home



#### CONTINUUM OF CARE

## Community-Based Permanent Housing

- Stable, long-term housing solutions that are integrated into local communities, typically offering ongoing support and services for individuals or families who have experienced homelessness to help them maintain housing stability.
- Agencies:
  - Habitat for Humanity, Housing Authority, Housing Development Corporation, Senior Housing Complexes (Catawba Crossing, etc), Catawba Mental Health, The Life House (upcoming)



## Permanent Supportive Housing

- A long-term housing option for individuals and families experiencing homelessness, which involves placing them in private rental units or other permanent housing with supportive services provided by the community.
- Agencies:
  - Housing Development Corporation, Pilgrims' Inn, HUDVASH, One80 Place






#### Components of a CoC

- YCIC serves to provide a forum for the purposes of providing a medium for all service agencies in York County, South Carolina.
  - Exchange service and other important information to facilitate service networking
  - Optimize interagency case management coordination for mutual clients, to unite the member agencies' voices for the purpose of initiating improvements in the local/regional delivery of health and human services
  - Offer an opportunity for members to create study groups/task forces to investigate concerns and areas of interest.

New volunteers are always welcome!


Donations of money, clothing, household items, toys, or books are welcomed! Receipts are available.


