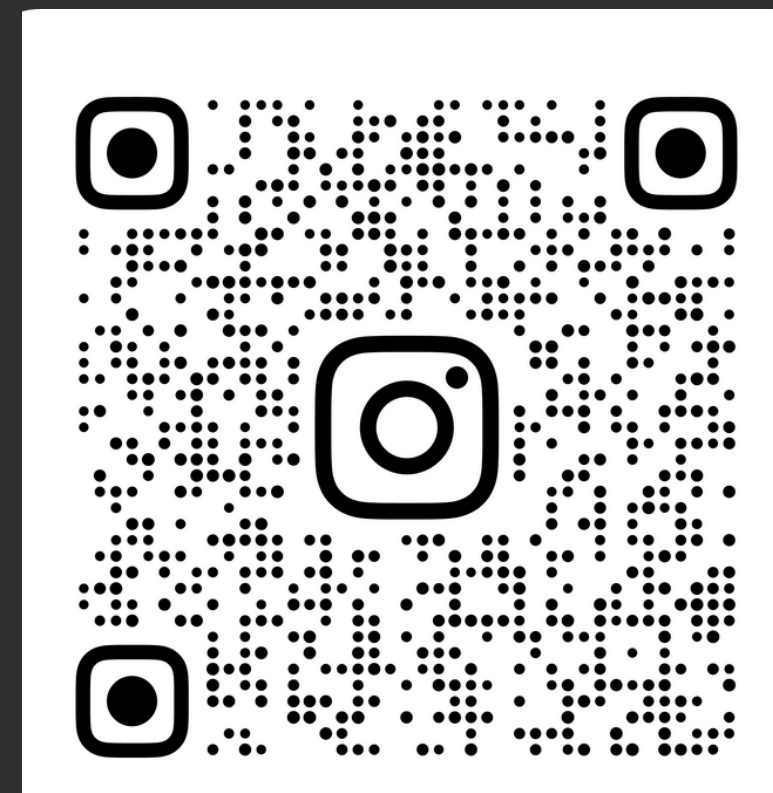
1. 2023 Continuum of Care Competition

OUR APPROACH



Street Outreach Team

To meet unsheltered individuals where they are, offering care and assistance

Resource Distribution Team

To provide support, resources, and hope to individuals experiencing homelessness

STREET OUTREACH PROGRAM OVERVIEW



What will we do?

- Locate, identify, and build relationships with individuals experiencing homelessness in the Catawba area
- Provides initial assessments and crisis counseling
- Address urgent physical needs (provide meals, blankets, clothes, toiletries, etc.)
- Actively connect individuals with information
- Refer individuals to homeless service providers and provide a warm handoff to mainstream social services and housing

STREET OUTREACH COMPONENTS



Who will we serve?

- The target population for street outreach will be unsheltered families and individuals
- A risk indicator of homelessness could be individuals doubling up, living in cars, and residing in hotels

STREET OUTREACH COMPONENTS



Who will serve on the street outreach team?

- Team Lead = CACH Outreach Coordinator
- Team Members = Service providers, law enforcement, health care professionals
 - Catawba Community Mental Health, Victims Advocates, Keystone Substance Abuse Services, FAVOR (Faces and Voices of Recovery), Police Departments, Sheriff's Office

STREET OUTREACH COMPONENTS



How often will street outreach take place?

- The Street Outreach Team will conduct its activities biweekly with the goal of eventually transitioning to a weekly schedule
- Focused on building relationships with individuals in need and working toward sustained support and progress

When will street outreach take place?

- Identify when individuals are in their respective encampments
 - Early mornings (6 AM - 8 AM) and late evenings (8 PM - 10 PM)

STREET OUTREACH COMPONENTS



Where will street outreach take place?

- Known encampments
 - A list will be created of known locations with specific addresses and identifiers
- Safe spaces for clients to meet the CACH Outreach Coordinator when the Street Outreach Team is not engaged

RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM OVERVIEW



What will we do?

- Go to public areas or "hot spots" where individuals experiencing homelessness are known to frequent
 - Library, bus hub, etc.
- Provide support, showing that our community cares for unhoused individuals
- Provide essential items (meals, blankets, clothes, toiletries, etc.)
- Provide hope, letting unhoused individuals know that there are resources available to help

RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION COMPONENTS



Who will we serve?

- Individuals and families we come into contact with that are in need of resources and essential items

RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION COMPONENTS



Who will serve on the street outreach team?

- Team Lead = CACH Outreach Coordinator
- Team Members = Volunteers

Note: While the Street Outreach Team is designed to provide professional support, the Resource Distribution Team is designed to engage our community members so that they become educated on the issue of homelessness and more aware of the need within our community.

RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION COMPONENTS



How often will resource distribution take place?

- The Resource Distribution Team will conduct its activities on a monthly basis and will focus on providing resources and essential items to a large number of people

When will street outreach take place?

- Specific date and time will be determined and the information sent out to those who are interested.

RESOURCE DISTRIBUTION COMPONENTS



Where will street outreach take place?

- Public spaces where individuals who are experiencing homelessness are known to frequent

POTENTIAL CHALLENGES



- Locating sites: Sites move frequently
- Transportation: Outside of Rock Hill and After bus hours
- Crisis Services
- Evening Protocol
- After Agency hours
- Identify best timeframes when individuals who are unsheltered are present at encampment sites

CAPACITY BUILDING

- Locate encampment locations
 - Police Department helps locate
- Street Outreach Team
 - Identify members
 - Commitment from members/ agencies
 - Implement Consistent Street Outreach
- Obtain and organize needed materials
 - Resources guides, hygiene kits, gift cards
- Develop the Rock Hill Street Outreach Team as the first step, before building capacity in Chester, Lancaster, and other towns/cities in York County
