Opioid Funding Opportunity

Who: On February 25, 2022, the National Prescription Opiate Litigation Plaintiffs' Executive Committee (PEC) finalized settlements totaling \$26 billion with three of the nation's top wholesale pharmaceutical drug distributors. More than \$100 million will be available for disbursement to South Carolina entities such as nonprofits, hospitals, state agencies, and others working to help address the opioid epidemic. The South Carolina Opioid Recovery Fund Board will oversee funds for counties and eligible municipalities, which must submit requests that seek funding for an approved abatement strategy listed in the settlement agreement.

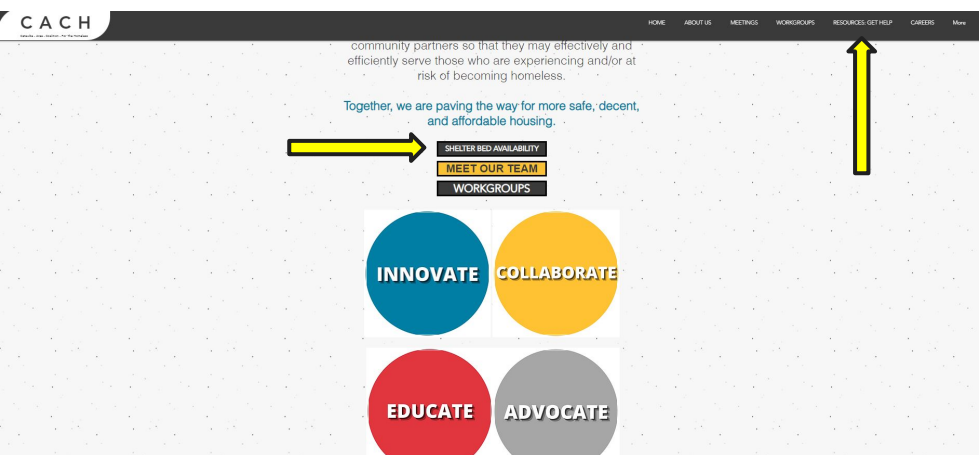
What: The Catawba Area Coalition for the Homeless is considering pursuing this funding. CACH would utilize these funds by awarding reimbursable grants to agencies in the City of Rock Hill that provide eligible services. These services include those that work to treat people with Opioid Use Disorder, assist people receiving treatment for Opioid Use Disorder, prevent the misuse and overprescription of opioids, work to reduce harm and deaths that occur as a result of opioid use, train first responders, complete opioid-related research, and educate the general public on the opioid crisis. Why: We believe that the Catawba Area Coalition for the Homeless is the perfect candidate to receive this funding, not only because of the research that shows the connection between homelessness and the opioid crisis but because of its ability to partner with agencies and organizations to tackle this issue from multiple angles.
