




MISSION:

• The formal letter states that LE from any jurisdiction is responsible for ensuring services (which may include a shelter bed) are guaranteed by Pathways and our Shelter partner(s) before leaving their client in our care.

Pathways will remain committed to connecting individuals and families (regardless of where they live/come from) to receive all <u>OTHER</u> <u>resources (non-shelter)</u> to become self-sufficient.
