

- Understand what homelessness looks like in our community
- Advocate for increased funding to address homelessness
- Tailor our services to meet the needs of individuals and families experiencing homelessness
- Better represent our fellow community members who are experiencing homelessness

## <u>2024 PIT COUNT - PROVIDERS</u>

### **Service Provider Information**

- To ensure that every individual experiencing homelessness in York County is represented, we ask that all service providers in York County participate in the 2024 PIT Count.
  - For providers who utilize HMIS, a shortened version of the PIT Count survey will be provided.
- To assist service providers during the PIT Count, we plan to station volunteers at service provider locations. Using the QR Code, please complete a short survey letting us know how many volunteers your agency will need during the count.
  - Note: This survey will also be emailed out to service providers.



## <u>2024 PIT COUNT - LAW ENFORCEMENT</u>

### Law Enforcement Information

- We will be reaching out to law enforcement officers in York County for information on known encampment sites and areas where we can send volunteers during the PIT Count.
  - Depending on the location, law enforcement might also be asked to escort volunteers to known locations.

- "Where did you sleep last night?"



### Friday, January 26th

- Counting Times: 6 AM 10 PM
- Counting Locations: Unsheltered and downtown locations throughout York County (excluding Rock Hill)
- "Where did you sleep on Wednesday night?"



### Saturday, January 27th

- Counting Times: TBD (based on operating hours of count locations)
- Counting Locations: Food pantries and soup kitchens in York County
- "Where did you sleep on Wednesday night?"




