WHAT IS LIHEAP?
The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) assists low-income households to meet their home heating and cooling needs.

WHAT DOES LIHEAP DO?
The program increases energy self-sufficiency by increasing awareness of energy conservation measures to reduce the household's energy burden. In addition to this, the program provides assistance with home energy bills, energy crises, and fans.

 **\$850 IN HEATING ASSISTANCE**
January - April, October - December


 **\$775 IN COOLING ASSISTANCE**
May - September

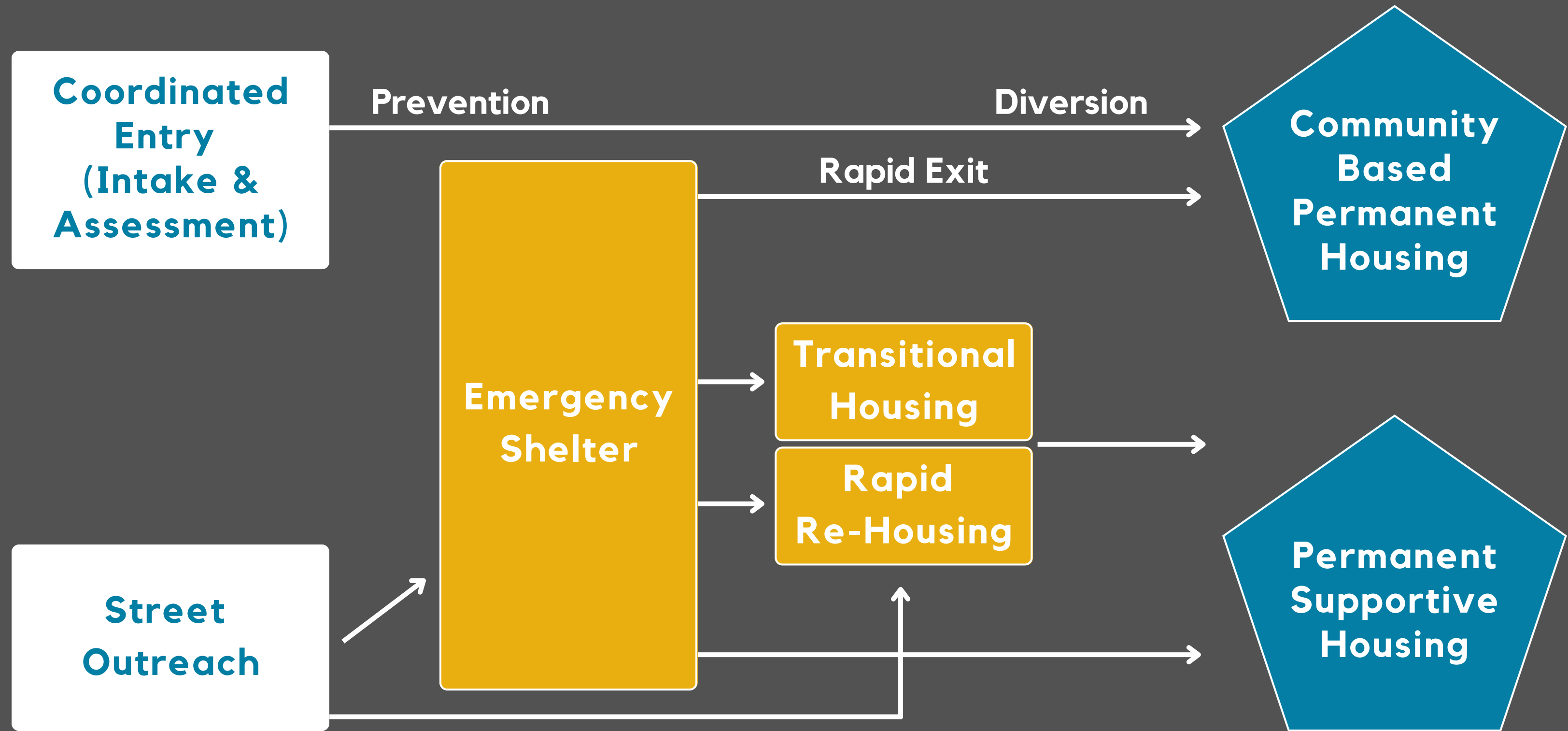
